Nancy Kahaian is a daughter, sister, aunt, niece, cousin, friend, and human companion to Miss Betty White, a little West Virginia white dog that she rescued when she served as the Interim Pastor in Charleston, the state capital. Most of her immediate and extended family reside in the metro Detroit area. She was raised on a small farm in Michigan, acquiring many skills that were integral to her appreciation of the natural world and her personal resilience. Her academic credentials include a Bachelor of Arts earned at Kalamazoo College, her Master of Divinity from Yale University Divinity School, and the Doctor of Ministry degree from McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago. Ordained as a Minister of Word and Sacrament for thirty-plus years, Nancy has served deep and wide in the Presbyterian Church USA as a Synod Executive in

Mid-America, and as a Presbytery Executive in a variety of contexts throughout the country. She was Chair of the General Assembly Council and was elected a General Assembly Commissioner, where she was appointed Chair of the Peacemaking and International Issues Committee. She has been an interim specialist for almost two decades of her professional service within the PCUSA.

She's a great cook, enjoys a daily early morning walk, reads like crazy, and looks forward to serving the congregation and community of Harbor Springs.

He leads Echoes of Mercy Mission that includes a large residential Christian School for the poor, that is gaining National accolades for academic excellence. They also have a huge outreach to widows with feeding program, building houses, farming for income generation and micro finance support. He is involved in planting Churches, raising up leaders, local evangelism and discipleship. They are also involved in orphan outreach and are currently finishing touches on a new modern orphanage building that will accommodate 200 children.
